

YOUR GUIDE TO LEAVING A GIFT IN YOUR WILL

Talk to your legal advisor about the type of gift that will best suit you and your estate. You may want to discuss your wishes with key family members and those close to you before confirming your intentions in your will.

Your Will

Talk to your legal advisor to prepare your will or to modify your current will.

Types of gifts

Share of your estate

Also known as a residuary gift, the residue of your estate is what remains of the estate once all of your loved ones and charges have been paid. A residuary gift could be a percentage or the whole of the residue of your estate.

Fixed sum

Also known as a pecuniary gift, this is where you leave an exact sum of money to specific charities.

Family Trust

If you have a family or inheritance trust in place, you may also wish to consider naming a charity as a beneficiary or include them in a 'Memorandum of Guidance' or 'Letter of Wishes' so that your intentions to leave a charitable gift can be honoured by the Trustees.

Currently under construction in the central city, Youth Hub Christchurch will provide everything Canterbury's young people need to maintain and improve their mental health from health and support services to recreation and creativity.

A first of its kind in New Zealand, the 'one-stop-shop' will also provide supported housing facilities for up to 40 young people.

More than 8000 young people between 10 and 24 are expected to walk through the Hub's doors annually once Stage One opens in late 2024.

The Trust continues to fundraise to build more supported housing units, as well as communal spaces for recreation, creativity, training, events, music and performing arts.
